

Boarding and Leasing at Full Moon Farm

Boarding

Full board cost is \$800 per month. Owners of horses that are used in the Lesson Program receive a discount, depending on the amount of the horse's use.

Board includes full use of the facilities, stall space, daily turnout, normal amounts of feed & hay, full tack room space, holding for farrier & dentist, and administration of supplements & medication.

A small fee is charged for blanketing (approx. October thru April) and for garlic (added to feed for fly control; approx. April thru September).

We do not allow jumping on your own in the Big Outdoor or in the Field ever. Boarders must use their own saddle pads. All boarders must be enrolled in the weekly lesson program.

Full Lease

Some FMF horses/ponies are available for full lease to our students (Ms. Karen's approval required). Full lease board costs range from \$475-\$600, depending on the mount.

Full lessees pay for most of the costs related to the horse's care, but are only responsible for a limited amount of medical costs. In return, full lessees have full access to their leased horse.

Leases are billed month-to-month, with 30 days' notice required for termination of the lease.

Includes: First choice of mount for showing and lessons, riding on your own at your convenience (by prior arrangement), full use of the facilities (as appropriate for mount and riding ability), jumping on your own in the Indoor and Little Outdoor (with permission of instructor), stall space, daily turnout, normal amounts of feed & hay, full tack room space, holding for farrier & dentist, and administration of supplements & medication.

Horse-use fees are waived for full lessees.

We do not allow jumping on your own in the Big Outdoor or in the Field ever. All lessees must be enrolled in the weekly lesson program.

Full lessees must use their own saddle pads, but may use the horse's school tack if it is not shared with another horse who is being used for a lesson at the same time. We highly recommend purchasing your own tack.

New leases must provide a new lead rope/lead chain for farm use. Please expect miscellaneous costs to arise, such as: new halters, bell boots, flymasks, blankets, stall fans, feed buckets, blanket cleaning, etc. All of these items become the property of the farm after 6 months.

Additional Full Lease costs are listed below, and will be added to your monthly board bill:

Half Lease

Some FMF horses/ponies are available for half-lease to our students (Ms. Karen's approval required).

Club Fee: \$200 for 12 month lease, \$100 for 6 month lease, or \$75 for 3 month lease.

This one-time fee is non-refundable and due at contract signing. If you take a break from a half-lease, you will have to pay a new Club Fee when you start another.

Club Fee is waived for Working Students with an ongoing weekly shift.

Monthly Cost: \$240.

Other Costs: Horse-use fees (for shows, clinics) still apply. Rider is responsible for the cost of having shoes drilled and tapped for studs (if needed for showing), and for replacement of shoes lost while riding on your own or at a show. All lessees must be enrolled in the weekly lesson program.

Benefits: First choice of mount for showing and clinics, 2 lease rides per week (scheduled at contract signing), use of the facilities (as appropriate for mount and riding ability), and partial tack room space. **We do not allow jumping on your own on a half lease.** Half lessees must use their own saddle pads, but may use the horse's school tack if it is not shared with another horse who is being used for a lesson at the same time. We highly recommend purchasing your own tack.

FMF Bucks for Horse-Use: Horse-Use Coupons will be issued at contract signing. These can be used during the lease term towards horse-use at events. Coupons expire at the end of the lease term, and cannot be used towards other costs. There is no refund for unused coupons. 12 Month lease = 8 coupons, 6 month = 4 coupons, 3 month lease = 2 coupons.

Scheduling: We will schedule the 2 recurring weekly ride times at contract signing (e.g., Tuesdays at 4:30pm and Sundays at 2pm). The office will provide you with a list of available ride times, which are based upon ring space and the lesson use of the leased horse. We require 24 hours' notice if you cannot attend a lease ride. Up to 2 lease rides may be rescheduled monthly, but only if we have received the 24 hours' notice of cancelation. These makeup rides must occur within the month they were canceled. All scheduled rides that conflict with FMF events may be rescheduled in advance.

Practice Rides

30-60 minute practice rides are available at \$45 per ride.

Instructor's permission is required to be eligible. You must be able to groom and tack on your own. **Jumping is not allowed during practice rides.** A signed contract must be on file with the office (prior to the first ride) to ensure the rider is aware of proper warm-up/cool-down and other riding responsibilities. Anyone who does a practice ride must be enrolled in the weekly lesson program.

Practice rides must be scheduled at least 48 hours in advance, and cannot be cancelled or rescheduled (except in approved extenuating circumstances). Rides are dependent on horse's availability and ring space. We will charge a late fee of \$10 if payment is not made at the time of the ride. Future practice rides will not be scheduled if the prior one hasn't been paid for.

Working Student Practice Rides

Working Students with a regular weekly shift may use their hours towards practice rides. Please call the office if interested.
