

INFORMATION for JEL & NCSSEL EQUITATION TEAMS

ncelus.com – Parents AND riders MUST read this information sheet in its entirety before committing.

About the Leagues: These partner leagues consist of riding schools throughout Maryland and Virginia. The goal is to allow riders to stay competitive during the fall/winter season (October through March), and to make competition more accessible to those that do not lease/own their own horse.

JUNIOR EQUITATION LEAGUE (JEL):

- 10 riders on a team, split into 5 divisions (2 riders per division):
- Divisions range from WT & poles to WTC & a course of 18" fences

NATIONAL CAPITOL SHORT-STIRRUP EQUITATION LEAGUE (NCSSEL):

- 6-9 riders on a team
- All riders must WTC and jump 18" (flat-only may also be possible)

Eligibility for Tryouts:

- Must be a rider enrolled in weekly lessons at Full Moon Farm.
- Each team/division has its own requirements in terms of abilities, but a good rule of thumb is that riders should be able to walk, trot, & go over poles on unfamiliar horses (without being led).
- If you have not been on a team before, ask your instructor about it!
 - If your instructor has encouraged you to do teams, it's a good idea to listen to them!

Team Info Meeting and Tryouts/Team Placements:

- July 6th at 7pm: Teams Info Meeting will be held at the Chateau. If you are new to teams, please plan to have at least one parent attend with your rider. If you cannot make the meeting, just let us know! We will try to do a Zoom meeting and can also set up a time to chat individually.
- July 20th & 27th: Tryouts/Team Placements
 - Please book one of the Team "Tryouts" via Hopoti (cost is \$27). *If you cannot attend either date, please let us know. You can still be on a team, and still need to pay the tryout/placement fee.*
 - Tryouts are for any spot on the JEL or NCSSEL team. The coaches decide who rides on which team—not the riders. If you sign up for tryouts, you agree to abide by the coaches' decision for whichever team you are assigned.
 - **Once determined, team placements are non-negotiable.** Rosters will be posted no later than 7pm Wednesday, July 29th. **If you do not back out** (must be done via email to ridewithfmf2@gmail.com) **by 10am on Tuesday, July 28th: You will be on the roster and will owe all fees associated with that team for the duration of the season**, including:
 - 2 lessons per week through Finale
 - Tryout fee, Team dues + League fee, and Finale fees

FMF EQUITATION TEAM COMMITMENTS:

Parent Commitments:

- 1. At least one parent per family must attend all 4 shows plus Finale.**
 - a. Away Shows: Travel to/from shows, help your rider (& their teammates!) as needed.
 - b. Home Shows: You will work during the whole show (you **will** be able to watch your own rider!). The host team runs the show, with help from our other teams & Fullmoonian volunteers!
- 2. At least one parent per family must help run the Food Booths.**
 - a. *Money earned from the Food Booth may be spent for your team!*
 - b. Home Shows for Your Team: Plan your Food Booth & provide the food. *Other FMF Team Parents will work at your Food Booth so you can help with your team's show & help/watch your rider!*
 - c. Home Shows for Other FMF Teams: You will volunteer for one 2-hour shift at one other FMF team's show, just as they do for you!

- i. You are welcome to volunteer at more than one Food Booth!
- 3. At least one parent per family must attend the team Work Day.**
 - a. *What is Work Day?* The team's riders and parents spend a few hours at the barn the day before their home show to prepare the horses, tack, arena, and barn. (This is usually right after Practice the day before the home show.)
- 4. At least one parent per family must attend the Paint Party for a minimum of 2 hours.**
 - a. The paint party is generally held on a Saturday in September/October. Any parent unable to attend must contact their coach to set up an alternative time to come help.
- 5. As with all FMF events, the parents'/family's time spent volunteering at shows can be logged as Volunteer Hours, with the following exceptions:**
 - i. No volunteer hours may be earned by a parent while working at **their rider's** home shows.
 - 1. No volunteer hours may be earned by a parent while working **their one required 2-hour** Food Booth shift (for another FMF team's home show).
 - 2. No volunteer hours may be earned by a parent while doing **their one required 2-hour** Paint Party shift. (*Additional hours may be logged as Volunteer Hours!*)

Rider Commitments:

- 1. Riders must maintain a positive attitude and exhibit good sportsmanship at all times.**
 - a. Absolutely no trash-talking/blaming other riders, horses, barns, coaches, parents, etc.
- 2. Riders must be scheduled in at least 2 lessons per week beginning no later than the week of Sept. 6th until the end of the team season.**
 - a. At least one lesson must be a group lesson, but we highly recommend doing two group lessons— this gives riders the chance to practice sharing the arena with other horses and riders and provides the chance to learn through observation. Plus, riding with friends is a lot of fun!
 - b. Riders' twice-weekly lessons from Sept. 6th–Feb. 6th must be booked **no later than Aug. 29th**, to give us ample time to ensure everyone is enrolled in their required lessons.
 - i. **Starting with the Oct. 4th lesson Season:** Your 2 weekly lessons **must** be booked with the 18-week Season option through Feb. 6th.
 - ii. **Starting with the Feb. 7th, 2027 lesson Season:** Your 2 weekly lessons **may** be booked with the 18-week Season option **OR** as individual lessons through Finale (typically early March), but must be booked **no later than Jan. 2nd**, so we can ensure everyone is enrolled in their required lessons.
 - c. Riders are expected to schedule a makeup for any missed lessons or team practices.
- 3. Riders must work their team's Work Day for their home show(s).**
- 4. Riders must attend the Paint Party for a minimum of 2 hours.**
 - a. Any rider unable to attend must contact their coach to set up an alternative time to come help.
 - b. This is a fun time to be together and meet other riders before our season officially begins. It's your chance to make all of our jumps & cavalettis look fresh and fantastic!
- 5. Riders must volunteer at other Home Shows for our other FMF teams.**
 - a. Riders must do two 3-hour shifts at other FMF home shows (iJEL, NCSSEL, NCAEL, or IEA).
 - i. Sign-ups for volunteering will be posted in advance.
 - b. After the mandatory 6 hours of volunteer time is met, time spent volunteering at shows can be logged as Volunteer Hours.
 - c. **Remember:** Time spent volunteering means helping, not standing around/eating/chatting/watching. If you stay longer than your required shift, that's great, but you're fair game and will be expected to keep helping!

FMF EQUITATION TEAM COST COMMITMENTS:

League Fee <i>credit may be issued if rider backs out by deadline</i>	July 20th	\$65
Team Dues <i>credit may be issued if rider backs out by deadline</i>	July 6th (Early Bird rate) or July 20th (Regular rate)	\$440* (<i>*Early Bird rate if paid on/before July 6th</i>) or \$460 (<i>if paid on/after July 7th</i>)
Show Fees (4 shows per season)	Will be collected by the Team Parent prior to each show	Likely \$55 per show (may vary by league/year)
Team Jacket	Order will be placed around Sept. 1st	Approx. \$100-125 (plus shipping, if applicable)
Finale Fees	Approx. 3 weeks before Finale	TBD (was \$190 in 2026; final amount due per rider will depend on fundraising)
Banquet Costs	Late February-Early March	TBD - Highly recommended for each rider and at least one parent to attend (was \$60/ticket in 2023)

Cost Descriptions:

- 1) Tryout Fee: Covers the cost of Tryouts/rider evaluations.
 - a) Nonrefundable.
 - b) For equity purposes and to cover the time the coaches spend evaluating every rider: Even if you cannot attend Tryouts, you still owe the Tryout fee if you wish to join a team.

- 2) Team Dues + League Fee: Covers your coaching costs (at the 4 regular-season shows) and the 4 team practices. Covers the team's League Dues, which pays for part of the admin time it takes to run teams and participate in the leagues.
 - a) If you email ridewithfmf2@gmail.com to notify us that you will not participate in Teams **PRIOR to 10am on July 28th**, we can **credit** the amount paid to your account (no refunds).
 - b) Team Dues + League Fees will NOT be waived/credited/refunded (for any reason!) after the July 28th 10am deadline.

- 3) Show Fees: Covers the costs we pay to each host-barn.
 - a) These payments will be due before each show. Riders unable to participate in a show do not need to pay that show's fee.
 - b) Riders will give their payments to Team Parents, who will then give payments to FMF.

- 4) **Finale Costs:** Covers the costs of the JEL/NCSSEL Finale weekend.
- a) Date and Location TBD (Likely a Fri-Sun during the first half of March)
 - b) We trailer some of our own horses off-site for Finale.
 - c) Proceeds from your team's Home Show Food Booth & Fundraisers can be used towards these costs– it's up to your team to decide!
 - d) Costs for Finale include:
 - i) Entry Fee (was \$50/rider in 2026)
 - ii) Horse-Use Fee (\$50/rider; waived if your own horse is used at Finale)
 - iii) Coaching Fee (\$50/rider)
 - iv) Trailering Fee (split equally amongst the riders; was \$75/horse in 2026)
 - v) Stabling Fees (split equally amongst the riders; was \$98/horse in 2026)
 - vi) Coaches' expenses (split equally amongst the riders)
- 5) **Banquet Costs:** Covers your share of the costs for Banquet (Awards Ceremony), including a fraction of the coaches' Banquet costs.
- a) Date and Location TBD (likely a Sunday in mid-to-late April)
- 6) **Team Jacket:** All riders must have a blue FMF team jacket to wear to all team shows.
- a) Sign-up and payment instructions will be posted/announced in mid-August, if not sooner.
 - b) Pricing is determined by the jacket company, but usually runs around \$100-125.
 - c) Family members are also encouraged to buy their own jackets!
 - d) Sometimes, team riders will sell their used jackets to new riders. If you'd like a used jacket, please email ridewithfmf2@gmail.com or reach out to a former team member to see what's available.
