Everyone:

Horse & Rider Prep:

1. Review draft of Itinerary. Everything is subject to change, depending on weather, footing, etc. While we won't have time to do everything we'd love to cover, if you notice that something is not on the Itinerary that you'd be interested in, please let us know!
2. Review USEA's Complete Event Checklist, and make sure you have all the items you'll need. If you're not sure if you'll need it, please ask!

 - a. If you don't have one already, purchase an Optimum Time Event Watch and practice using it, so you're ready to use it on Day 1.
 - b. Make sure you have a sufficient supply of all sprays, ointments, shampoo, etc. you typically use.
3. Have your horse's mane pulled/solocombed so it's ready to braid on Day 1
 - a. Bring mane pulling/thinning and braiding supplies– whatever you typically use.
4. Make sure you and your horse are fit enough for the level you plan to compete at. If your goals/plans change, let us know– we're happy to accommodate!
